Allco JM TPO is a thermoplastic polyolefin (TPO) roofing membrane. Manufactured using ultraviolet-resistant formulation and reinforced with fabric polyester, JM TPO offers extreme pliability, flexibility and weldability during installation. The single ply roofing membrane is a reliable and cost-effective solution ideal for low slope roofing, decks and balconies.

Allco JM TPO is manufactured by Johns Manville (JM), one of the most respected and technologically advanced waterproofing membrane manufacturers in the world, servicing customers in more than 80 countries globally.

## SUITABLE APPLICATIONS

Allco JM TPO is suitable for commercial and residential low-slope and pitched roofs, gutters, parapets, balconies, and under floating decks.

JM TPO is ideal for waterproofing a wide variety of new substrate surfaces or to rejuvenate failed or worn-out existing membranes which are nearing their "use by date".

JM TPO is also used as the waterproofing membrane for our ALLTHEM Warm Roof, ALLRITE Recover Roof and Cold Roof solutions.

### THICKNESS OVER SCRIM

JM TPO is available in 3m and 3.6m wide, making it ideal for larger roofs installations as well as available a 1.14 and 1.52 mm thickness guaranteeing a high-strength, tear and puncture resistance membrane whilst maintaining high pliability, flexibility and weldability during installation.

### INTEGRITY IN HARSH ENVIRONMENTS

Allco JM TPO has been vigorously tested by submitting it to temperatures of over 115°C for over 224 days. TPO membranes that can withstand these high temperatures for sustained periods have stronger seam welds and more integrity to protect your roof from the elements guaranteeing test of time in the harshest environmental conditions.

### ENERGY SAVING

The lighter coloured TPO reflects solar energy lowering the amount of heat absorbed into the building, greatly reducing cooling energy loads and costs. The reduction in energy consumption contributes towards a building's green start rating.

## TECHNICAL

---

### NZBC COMPLIANCE

Allco JM TPO when installed and maintained in accordance with the supplier's instructions and maintenance requirements will satisfy the durability clause NZBC B2.3.1 (b) 15 years. Allco JM TPO meets the relevant clauses of NZBC E3 Internal Moisture and F2 Hazardous Building Materials.

### DESIGN REQUIREMENTS

Product specification and incorporation of Allco JM TPO into the building design shall be carried out by a designer, or architect, or engineer, or building professional who; is qualified to design the buildings covered under the "Scope of use" of this product; and has ready access to the technical specifications including installation details and standards referenced to in the BRANZ Appraisal No.1046 (2018) where the design limitations are outlined for the scope of this PTS.

Allco JM TPO is supplied as a complete system with proprietary heat weldable accessories to deal with roof penetrations including internal and external corners and pourable pockets. Refer to the Allco website or contact an Allco Account Manager for a full list of accessories.

### INSTALLATION

Installation shall be carried out by an Allco Approved Applicator. Installation shall be undertaken in accordance with all relevant technical information related to the selected installation method, including information contained within the BRANZ Appraisal No. 1046 (2018) and the suppliers installation instructions.

### SPECIFICATION & SUBSTITUTION

## MAINTENANCE REQUIREMENTS

---

Maintenance requirements for Allco JM TPO are outlined in Allco's Care & Maintenance Guide. In the event of damage to the membrane, the membrane must be repaired by an approved applicator only, who can remove the damaged portion and heat weld a patch, the same as for new work. Drainage outlets must be maintained to operate effectively.
